Dear Grayhawk Families,

In response to teacher and community discussions, Grayhawk has adopted a new school wide behavior program. This program is called PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) and is a system of support that includes proactive strategies for defining, teaching, and supporting appropriate student behaviors to create positive school environments. We have developed specific expectations across campus as a means to set students up for success. We will also be using reflection sheets when needed as a means to increase communication between school and home with regard to behaviors which are not within acceptable expectations. You will also see "Pawsitively Awesome!" cards coming home with your child. These cards help all of us recognize students many positive behaviors.

We are continuing with our All Things E.Q. program. All Things E.Q. helps to guide our school community to "show up" positively for ourselves and others. It increases student engagement, achievement, and campus-wide well-being. The best part about All Things E.Q. is that it provides a platform for parents to know what conversations students and teachers are having at school. A Note from Nurse Ann

Hello everyone!

I want to take a moment today and remind everyone of the required steps should your child need medication at school. Please stop in the nurse's office and complete a Medication Administration form or you can find one on the district website. I will need this form for prescription and nonprescription medication. Please provide all medication in the original container labeled with the student name, and dose direction included on the label. Oh and don't forget to check the expiration date!

PVUSD policy prohibits children from transporting medication; please do not send medication to school with your child. If medication is found by a young child it could result in a very dangerous situation.

Thank you for your help in keeping all students safe!
